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DAY 1: WELCOME TO SPAIN!

Welcome to Barcelona! Meet your driver who will transfer you to your centrally located hotel in Barcelona. Rest of the day at your leisure.
Overnight at the hotel in Barcelona.

DAY 2: TRANSFER FROM BARCELONA TO PALAMOS AND HIKE TO CALELLA DE PALAFRUGELL

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Palamos with its exceptional views of the Costa Brava. Moving with the crashing waves, in the shadow of Mediterranean pine trees, you will hike blending with the environment, step by step. As you breathe deeply, you'll feel like the inhabitants of this land, part of its creativity and art. At noon, you will have a lunch of Mediterranean food in a restaurant on the beach in Palafurgell that will ignite your senses.
Overnight in Palafurgell.

DAY 3: FROM TAMARIU TO BEGUR

It is a 4-miles hiking path on the coast. As the area has been protected, the environment has facilitated the establishment of several important species. You'll be taken back in time when visiting the medieval village of Pals, walking through the cobbled streets of the perfectly preserved town center.
Overnight in Palafurgell.

DAY 4: MONTGRI' CASTLE

Between the Pyrenees and the Mediterranean, has been a place of passage and conquests. It was a vantage point from where the battles were planned between lords, defense against French pirates and raids. This Itinerary takes you to the beach in L'Estartit. Then you rest in Aiguablava which is one of the most beautiful corners of the Costa Brava, surrounded by cozy coves and crystal-clear waters, where the pine trees bathe their roots, giving it an unforgettable charm.

DAY 5: THE DALI' THEATER-MUSEUM

The Dalí Theater-Museum is the largest surrealist place in the world. It occupies the building of the former Village Theatre, a 19th century building destroyed during the Spanish Civil War. On its ruins, Dalí decided to create his museum. Cap de Creus, windswept and a shelter for Dalí, is a spectacular and rugged end of the Pyrenees, where they plunge into the Mediterranean in a fascinating landscape of loneliness and restlessness. This is the area that inspired the film 'The light at edge of the world' 1971, with its range of sensations of nature in its purest state. Let your imagination go wild and visit the Monastery of Sant Pere de Rodes s X-XI.
Return to Barcelona and overnight.



DAY 6: BARCELONA

Spend the morning in Barcelona, visiting the most iconic places such as The Sagrada Familia and Park Guell, or just take a walk at the beautiful beaches.

In the evening, you will dive in the world of Tapas! You will meet your tour guide who will transport you to the wonders of the Catalan cuisine, through bars, restaurants and wineries. Squeeze the most out of the evening with platillos, tapas, bottles of wines, well poured ales and lots of good humor.

DAY 7: BARCELONA

The morning is at your leisure. Around 4pm, you will be awaited at your E-bike Tour meeting point. On this tour, you will travel back in time to discover an unknown side of Barcelona through the eyes of Picasso, the most famous painter of the 20th century. While riding through old backstreets and modern neighborhoods, you will get to know some of the most vivid contrasts that Barcelona offers. And by the end of the tour, you will have the impression to have experienced the changes Barcelona has gone through and have felt at the same time the exciting city Picasso used to know.

DAY 8: ADIOS

Today you will be transferred to the airport for your international flight.
